On August 11, 2020, when Russia announced that the vaccines were cleared to move for scale-up productions, our eyes widened with hope. Kirill Dmitriev, CEO of the Russian Direct Investment Fund and the main backer of Sputnik V, claimed that they are looking for a mass-production partnership with India. He said, "We believe that they are capable of producing the Gamaleya vaccine, and it is very important to say that those partnerships will enable us to cover the demand that we have." It looks like the 'Vladimir Putin-led' nation is looking to join hands with India, to produce it for the world. All of this led to overnight joy for Indians. The Sputnik V vaccine consists of two shots, using different versions of adenoviruses. With having done 20,000 clinical trials, the Russian President has requested for global cooperation. As the vaccine has to undergo tests in various countries, Dmitriev highlighted, "We are going to do clinical trials not just in Russia but also in the UAE, Saudi Arabia, probably in Brazil, and India." With demand as high as 1 billion doses from countries like Latin America, Asia, Italy, etc. the million-dollar question is - will Sputnik V come to India? While this question stays unanswered, some say that there is no way to be sure right now; while, others question the efficiency and the safety of the vaccine as there is no peer-reviewed data on the same.

In the audio recording of the officer, Blake had the possession of a knife whereas witnesses affirm to not detecting it. Due to the absence of body cameras, it is considerably perplexing to evaluate the situation without the statements of Jacob Blake. With portions of the story dissipated around, the public outraged with the current crisis of police brutality against Blacks. Social media has played an enormous function in this problem as "Justice For Jacob Blake" trends, and supporters of BLM battle for justice. Jacob Blake has court charges after him for sexual assault and domestic abuse to which several people think to be pertinent to the oral mettle between Blake and Sheskey.
